USE:

TriBond is used as an adhesion promotor on any clean, unpainted tub, tile or kitchen surface. It can also be used on ferrous and non ferrous metals for improved adhesion. On extremely glossy surfaces and acid etch may be desired for maximum bond strength, but in most cases, only the removal of mineral deposits and soap scum is necessary for long term adhesion.

- Shower floor pans
- Kitchen countertops

Application Data

REQUIREMENTS

- Surface and ambient temperatures must be above 60° F and 5° F above dew point during application.
- Surface must be completely free of all contaminants: all dirt, grease, oils, soap scum, mineral deposits, etc. Washing surface with **White Mountain Jobsite Cleaner** is recommended.
- Silicone caulking and surface protectants must be completely removed; washing will not affect them. Any residual silicone will cause paint failure.
- Surface must be completely dry.
- Fiberglass and cast polyester "cultured marble" surfaces must be well sanded with 400 grit wet or dry sandpaper prior to application of TriBond.
- Wearing NIOSH approved organic vapors particulate respirator, solvent resistant gloves, eye protection goggles is required. An air supplied hood with head and face protection is recommended.

FILM DEVELOPMENT & THICKNESS:

TriBond is applied at extremely low levels. It does NOT form a notable film. Apply in one coat to produce a chemically treated surface. Typical substrates include tub and tile surfaces such as ceramic, porcelain glazed or un-glazed tile and various metals. Actual application rates vary. Surfaces only need to appear briefly wet, not dripping. General coverage estimate is 800 sq ft/gal.

MIXING-THINNING: None. Use as is. APPLICATION:

TriBond is designed for hand application by wiping on clean surfaces with a clean, lint free cloth. Apply **Liquid Porcelain** refinishing enamel as soon as possible after **TriBond** has been applied. Reseal **TriBond** container to prevent spoilage.

CLEANUP SOLVENT: ... Ethyl or isopropyl alchohol
